MATTERS ARISING

.1 Van

A fee needed to be set for the hire of the van, and in the event this was agreed as follows:- £5 per day (£10 per weekend) with a minimum charge of £2.50p.

As the guides were the only users of the van it was decided to invite Mrs Virji to our next meeting to discuss this hire charge and the fact that we have to date made no charge towards the cost of insuring the van for their (guides) use.

We originally charged 20p per mile. One St Albans Scout Group charge £20 for weekend usage of their van.

FUND RAISING COMMITTEE

Martin Barratt, as Chairman of the re-formed FRC, was given a broad outline of past fund raising events. One suggestion handed to Martin by Hazel was a diary, whereby, dates could be sold for 25p each with the winner receiving a £10 M&S voucher as first prize and £5 as second prize. All the funding raising float (£30) originally held by Frank Hulley had been absorbed in last year's Lamb Roast.

A date was fixed for our next Jumble Sale - Saturday 25 September 1982, 2pm. (Ann to contact Herts Ad and Review, Hazel to organise the printing of posters & leaflets). Leaflets would again be distributed through the Midweek Advertiser on a Tuesday some ten days before the 25/9/82.

It was agreed that tickets (approx 1000) should be printed and sold in respect of raising money on the Football signed by Watford FC. Anna to contact Roger Evans re printing. David Ward had been the instigator of this signed football in an effort to raise money for new cub football strip, and it was felt that with the World Cup taking place it would be a good time to hold the raffle.

ACTION

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Perhaps Graham Taylor of Watford FC could make the draw? A second prize could be offered possibly in the form of a voucher from Riders to cover the cost of a football shirt of the winner's choice.

It was suggested that we would try and sell something to boost our funds - possibly the football raffle tickets and cakes.

It was agreed that we could not participate in the August Bank Holiday Carnival as too many members were away on holiday.

Christmas Disco arranged for Tuesday 21 December but prior to that a Disco would be held on Tuesday 26 October 7-9pm for under 13's.
